**Critical Analysis of a 20 Century
Theory, Manifesto, Paradigm**

&

Graphical Analysis of a Built Project

Oral Presentation & 8X8-Illustrated Paper

First, read the book, articles, chapters in R1 or R2, etc. and identify the theoretical position of the author and its essential themes and topics.

Research the built projects mentioned in the chapter and, for one of them, collect graphical information such as drawings, photographs, diagrams, sketches, etc.

Write an 800 words paper summarizing the main thesis of the theory and its arguments. Discuss examples, background, and influence of the theory.

Graphically analyze the selected project based on collected drawings from a variety of source.

Drawings should include plan, section, elevation, site plan, details, etc.

Prepare a PowerPoint presentation
(8 slides & notes).

Slides should
quote exact words sparingly,
paraphrase some of the content,
and summarize the main points of your written
paper.

illustrate the selected project,
graphically analyze the project with diagrams,
and show how the theory is illustrated in the built
work.

Add notes to each slide:

discussing in detail the theoretical position of the author, the definition of new concepts he introduces, and the sources you have consulted. Notes should also discuss your analysis of the built work in written format.

Add a caption to each figure and identify their sources.

Part 2. Printed Paper
(8" X 8"-horizontal banner)

Due Dec. 8

From your research and presentation, design an 'illustrated paper' documenting your critical examination and graphical analysis of the theoretical position and the built work.

Make diagrams, ideograms, drawings, overlays, etc. to communicate your points visually.

Add a Bibliography (MLA-style) and Identify the Sources of your figures.
