## **International Coffee Building**

### **Final Project**

#### **Intro:**

Your final project is the completion of the International Coffee Building designed as the offices of Buffalo Bayou Partnership, a café, canoe and kayak rental facilities as well as additional exhibit display space. The project required restroom facilities to be added as well as an elevator.

#### **What to Present:**

- 1) Select no more than 3 sheets from your research work
- 2) Site Plan Context (2 blocks surrounding site in all directions)
- 3) Site Plan Immediate (this should include all modifications to site including the location of rental equipment storage. In addition, include all site furnishings, landscape, pathways and green roof. This should be a complete site plan)
- 4) Floor Plans
- 5) Elevations
- 6) (2) Sections
- 7) (1) Site Section through bayou and Commerce Street
- 8) (5) Exterior perspective drawings addressing the character and experience of the site. Must Include: approach to the building, experience at landing, green roof.
- 9) (3) Detail drawings
- 10) Mechanical Systems Information (You do not have to include a mechanical system drawing, but you do need to be able to present the system you are using and indicate it in a drawing. This could be presented with your research sheets).
- 11) Additional drawings you feel are necessary to express your design fully.

NOTE: When creating perspective drawings, remember to add people and activity. The experience of the place assumes there is great activity and your drawings are experienced more fully when they are integrated into these drawings.

#### **REMEMBER:**

Post your work to the website.

Print out the full 11x17 drawing sheets for submittal.

Produce two boards at no greater than 24x36 for overall final review.
