

Book Requirement

Due by commencement date, December 19, 2009

Format:

- 8.5" x 8.5" book format size – so make sure your images and drawings are readable at this size.
- You will be allowed 12 pages – this means 12 single sheets of 8.5"x8.5", not 24.
- Images sized as you wish to fit in your format at 300dpi
- Any full size photos or drawings that you wish to consume a full page may lead to exact page edge, any others, must respect the following:
 - Right side page: 1" left side(bound side), ½ " top, bottom and right side (open side)
 - Left side page: ½ " left side(open side), top, bottom; 1" right side (bound side)
- Do not number pages

YOUR SEGMENT:

Your segment will become part of an online publication we will produce representing the studio work. Your segment should convey the urban design process as well as the idea as development. Ask yourself: How you began, what relevant research influenced your ideas (do not forget to cite any work gathered from outside), what elements of exploration and exercise shaped your direction, what question you are attempting to answer and finally, the possibilities that come from this question. It should include text as well. The text is intended to represent your thoughts about the process, flooding, water, Houston and the drawings. We will use this as documentation of our work, as an exploration into the process and as a way to reflect. It is important that your work express an inquiry into a question – the question you pose through your idea – as we *rethink* flooding in Houston. You will write a reflection paragraph for your work as well. It should answer what you have learned from the process and how it impacts the way you see Houston as a city that floods. We'll include this in the conclusion of the book.

ITEMS:

- 1) You will place your work in a folder with your name:
FirstLast_Chapter under your student folder.
I will get it from this location.
- 2) Provide a pdf so I can see the layout you choose (or word publisher)
All Images included at exact size and 300 dpi.
- 3) Provide all images at 300 dpi and actual size (to fit the layout) (these are the images you have laid out for your segment of the book)
- 4) Provide all text in word using Calibri font, 11pt. (this will allow me to cut and paste into book format)
- 5) Remember, anything you use from an outside source must be cited. I need this info for the reference section. If you don't do this, you will risk plagiarism and once it is on the internet, I cannot modify that.
- 6) Remember, you are picking and choosing from your work throughout the semester to best express your work. Some of you may want to use one or two sketches, and then most of your later final work. Others will be better supported to have a balance.
- 7) Give your work a title
- 8) Provide a cover design. I'll select from these and the one selected will receive their book for free.
