Consider that Jones Plaza redesign will be a significant public space.

Consider that you will design for a high level standard which meets of the adjacent buildings.

1) Take your mind map and site analysis and from the ideas and thoughts generated through these processes, develop three conceptual ideas for the redesign of Jones Plaza.

2) Represent these concepts through drawings and diagrams.

3) Further progress the three concepts by taking each concept and generate a mind map. This means that you will place one concept in the center circle and from this, create the new mind map. Do this for each of your three concepts.

4) Based on your three concepts – select the one you feel is strongest and develop a problem statement.

Problem statements should be open ended. Don't assume a solution in the statement. For example, it may be something like, "Helping users experience a great public space". You could elaborate on this, but remember not to imply the design solution in your statement (don't tell us what or how you are going to do it).

You will show all work electronically through an in class review. From this date you will receive the final design requirements for your final review.
